CATECHETICAL THEME: What Benefits Does Baptism Give?

This Week's Catechetical Theme: What Benefits Does Baptism Give?

The Small Catechism answers this week's question quite clearly, identifying three blessings bestowed in Baptism: Forgiveness, rescue from death and the devil, and eternal salvation. What great blessings these are, for they are the gifts Christ freely gives. And He gives these gifts wherever He gives His gifts: through the preaching of the Gospel, and also the administration of the Sacraments. This is no man-made list of blessings; this is the list of blessings given in Holy Scripture to all who have salvation by grace through faith in Christ. Where there is forgiveness, there is rescue from death and eternal life! The Small Catechism quotes Mark 16:16, but throughout the week, as you make use of the Bible Readings for the Family and Congregation, you will discover additional passages that teach the same. God bless your time in His Word!

The Catechism: What benefits does Baptism give?

It works forgiveness of sins, rescues from death and the devil, and gives eternal salvation to all who believe this, as the words and promises of God declare.

Which are these words and promises of God? Christ our Lord says in the last chapter of Mark: "Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned." (Mark 16:16)
